Only two weeks until Open House and 21 days until the first day of school! Please review the following important information and plan accordingly.

OPEN HOUSE – Thursday, August 24

What time should I attend Open House on Thursday, August 24th?

*Students whose last name begins with A-M should plan to attend Open House 4:00–5:45 p.m.

*Students whose last name begins with N-Z should plan to attend Open House 5:45–7:30 p.m.

Reminder: Those who would like to get a head start and avoid the long lines for pictures at Open House are welcome to join us for pictures at the high school building only on August 17 for our NEW (optional) pre-Open House picture opportunity.

INFINITE CAMPUS ONLINE REGISTRATION REQUIRED (ALL RETURNING FAMILIES)

All families with students RETURNING for the 2023-2024 school year MUST complete the <u>Annual Update in Infinite Campus</u>. This will include verifying demographic information and requesting transportation. This NEW streamlined process keeps all information in one place and ensures families complete all necessary information for each student for the upcoming school year. All families (including returning students) requesting transportation (busing) for a student must complete this process.

NEW SCHOOL BREAKFAST/LUNCH PROGRAM

As you may have heard, the Minnesota legislature passed a new law in the spring of 2023 requiring all schools that receive federal funding through the free and reduced meal program to make available free breakfast and free lunch for all students. Spectrum is continuing to make plans for the implementation of these new requirements. This will require significant logistical changes for the Spectrum food service program.

Spectrum will be working with a new caterer this year, **CKC Good Food (CKC)**, to increase our capacity from approximately 200 lunches and no breakfast daily to serving up to 900 breakfasts and lunch daily. **CKC** is anxious to work with Spectrum and will be introducing themselves at <u>Open House</u> on Thursday, August 24th, where they will be serving samples of their menu items to students and families under the big tent.

While all meals will be free to students, in order to receive a free breakfast or lunch, <u>families</u> will be required to complete a meal order monthly for each <u>student</u>. This will allow Spectrum to order the correct number of meals and ensure meals are available for their students. **Order forms will be going out later this week**.



School breakfast will be brand new to Spectrum and there are many logistics to serving 900 students in a 25 minute timeframe with a cafeteria that accommodates a much smaller number of students at one time. Northstar will be aiming to have buses arrive at school between 7:10-7:20 a.m. to accommodate those interested in eating breakfast. School buildings will continue to open at 7:00 a.m. with school starting at 7:25 a.m. Breakfast will be available 7:00-7:20 a.m. Car riders interested in eating breakfast should plan accordingly.

EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS/FREE AND REDUCED APPLICATION

While all school meals will be free to all students starting this school year, Spectrum highly encourages all families who qualify for free and reduced benefits under the federal guidelines to continue filling out the application and submitting it prior to the start of the school year. Note: A new application must be submitted each year. The updated Educational Benefits Application will be available soon on the school website HERE.

Here a handful of additional benefits for families, their students, and the school when qualifying families complete and submit their applications:

- Spectrum receives government grant funding based on the number of attending students who qualify for free and reduced benefits. This funding can be \$30,000-\$50,000 and helps to pay for staffing of courses that serve the needs of students performing below grade level. Other federal grants are often tied to these applications.
- Families who qualify for free and reduced benefits (based on the completed applications) have access to discounted fees on school-related field trips and activities.
- Other low cost or free opportunities may include fees for certain types of educational testing.
